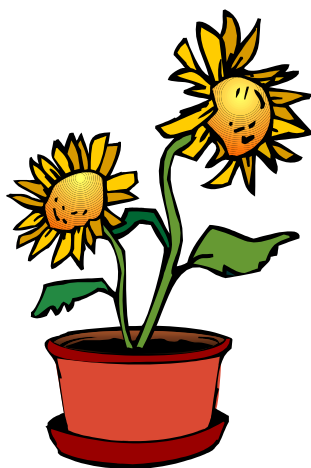


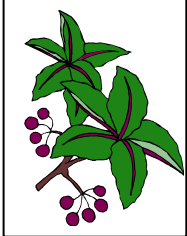

RULES

- (A) All exhibits must be at the Show Pavilion between 10:00 am – 2.00 pm Sunday 30th July.
Entry forms and Fees should also be lodged by Sunday 30th July to the Stewards noted above.
- (B) Entry Fees – all classes **\$1.00**
(No exhibit is acceptable unless an entry fee has been paid for and a completed entry form forwarded to the steward) – Entry Form is attached.
- (C) Prize money to be collected from the Office upon production of a Prize Payout card during the show until 5pm Sunday 6th August.
- (D) Judging will commence at 10 am Thursday, 3rd August 2023
- (E) All Exhibitors are required to declare their Biosecurity number when entering an exhibit- Entry forms are to be fully completed to qualify for Prizes.
- (F) The Judge **may** mark down any exhibits entered in any previous Show, in the interest of ongoing fair competition.

Honey Court Sponsored by PINE RIVERS SHOW

CLASS – OPEN SECTIONS

1. One 500 gram bottle of Extracted Honey, light.
2. One 500 gram bottle of Extracted Honey, light golden.
3. One 500 gram bottle of Extracted Honey, dark golden.
4. One 500 gram bottle of Extracted Honey, dark.
5. One 500 gram bottle of Extracted Honey any colour for competitors who have not won a prize at **any** previous shows.
6. One 500 gram bottle of Creamed Honey.
7. One kilo Wax, natural yellow.
8. One kilo Wax, natural white.
9. Novice Wax 500 gram, any Natural Colour
10. Junior 500gm HONEY, any Colour
11. Junior 500gm WAX, any Natural Colour.

All Honey entries above must be accompanied by a 50ml plastic sample pot of the competitor's honey. **Please half fill your sample pots only.**

EXTRACTED HONEY SECTION:

- Honey in sections 1 – 6 must be shown in standard trade jars (round not paneled) and of clear glass with white top 62mm.
- 500gm jar filled, with air space of 6mm left at top of jar.
- All jars are to be clear of markings or stickers,
- Stewards will place stickers on entries to identify entrants.
- Limit of 2 entries per section.

Extracted Honey

Honey exhibited in Classes 1,2,3,4,5,6, and 10 must be shown in the standard trade jar approved by the Queensland Beekeepers' Association. The jar is round (not panelled) and of clear glass with white Top. It measures approximately: 120 mm with cap diameter 62 mm and contains 500g reputed net weight of honey.

To expedite judging, jars should be filled to capacity.

An air space of 6 mm to be left at the top of jar

All Jars are to be clear of all markings, stickers or identification marks.

Only stickers are to be ones placed on jars by stewards, to identify entrants

Junior Entry Up to 16 years

Class 10 500g jar Honey any colour

Class 11 Beeswax 500g natural any natural colour
