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# **Poultry Schedule**

#### Regulations for Saturday Novelty Class

- Open to all ages of fowls and exhibitors.
- These classes are open to any breed of fowls, not necessarily pure breeds.
- They can be your special backyard chooks, but they MUST be free of any life, stick fast fleas, scaly leg mite or any other problems or diseases.
- You MUST complete a Biosecurity form for all entries (See page 10).
- All entries must be presented in a clean and tidy condition.
- Entrants are encouraged to decorate the cages of each bird.
   There are no entry fees for this section and no prize money will be allocated for any winners of the
- Novelty Class. All Juvenile entrants in the novelty class will receive a ribbon and a card for their entries.

#### Regulations for Sunday Classes

- All entries to be submitted on the official Pine Rivers AH&I Association Entry Form. Cheques are to be payable to Pine Rivers AH&I Association.
- You MUST complete a Biosecurity form for all entries (See page 10).
   During the judging, all exhibits will be in the custody of the stewards and shall not be handled by
- the owner or any persons other than the judge or steward unless previous consent from a steward has been obtained.
- During the judging, exhibitors are asked to keep the judging area free so as not to hinder the judges or stewards.
- The judges decisions shall be considered final and no further discussion concerning the matter will be entered.
- •Any parasite infected, or diseased fowls will be disqualified and removed from the pavilion.
- Water containers will be provided by the Moreton Bay Regional Poultry Club for the well being of the exhibits and remain the property of the Poultry Club.
- Every care will be taken of the exhibits, but the committee will not be liable for damage, loss or death.
- No bird is to be removed early from the pavilion unless a clearance is obtained from the Chief steward.
- Presentation of awards will take place between 2.00pm and 3.00pm (approximately) on Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup>

  August. Birds are to remain penned until 4pm and only released under the guidance of the stewards.
