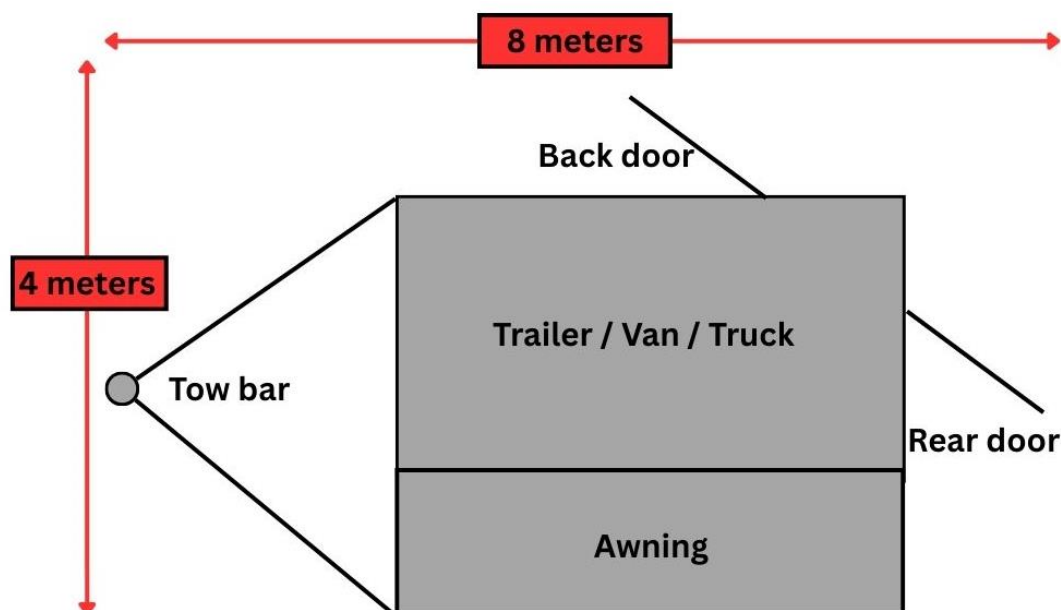


Important Information:

- A deposit is **NOT** required with your Site Application. Confirmation of successful site applicants will be advised by email no later than 20th April 2026. At this time, you will be issued with an Invoice for a 50% deposit for your site.
- Full Site fees must be paid by June 29th.
- The last day to withdraw and receive a refund for your site is June 26th. Any no shows or stallholders who withdraw after this date will not receive a refund.
- Allocation of sites are at the discretion of the Pine Rivers A. H. & I. Association and will be based on site sizes requested. It is important you state the total meterage required to access and operate your site (including room for your cold room if required).
- Site locations are not guaranteed year to year and will not be confirmed until bump in day.
- All sites must be set up by 9pm Thursday 30th July 2026 - **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- Exhibitors / Vendors must check in at the site office to collect their exhibitor's pack prior to proceeding to their site.
- Daily access for restocking is via Gate 3 (Pool gate) only between 6am – 8am Friday - Sunday
- All vehicles to be removed from the grounds into the public parking area by 8am.
- No vehicle movement before 5pm Sunday **NO EXCEPTIONS**.

How to measure your site:

We recommend you attach photos of your set up to your application to assist with placement.





Terms and Conditions

1. Lodgement of site application is not confirmation that you have been successful in securing a site at the 2026 Pine Rivers Show, due to the number and type of exhibits being strictly limited. Confirmation emails will be issued to applicants no later than 22nd April 2026.
2. Remittance of full site fees as stated in site confirmation email must be paid to the Pine Rivers AH&I Association (The Association) no later than Monday 29th June 2026. If the required remittance is not received by this date, the Association reserves the right to void your application and re-let the site to the next available applicant.
3. The exhibitor shall not assign or sub-let any part of their space without the consent of the Association in writing. The Association reserves the right to re-allocate space in the interest of providing a better showing of exhibits.
4. Failure to provide correct measurements of site (including towbars and door access) may void your application and the removal of your vehicle. Sites change with each show based on the requirements of the exhibitors / vendors, and sites are mapped accordingly. You are not guaranteed to have the same site as previous years.
5. Powered Sites must ensure all extension leads are above ground or covered as per regulations set down by Department of Health & Safety.
6. Current public liability certificate must be provided to the office before access to the grounds. No certificate No Access. Food vendors are required to provide food licence where applicable. All exhibitors/vendors must comply with relevant regulations issued by the Department of Health, Moreton Bay Regional Council Health Department, and the Queensland Fire Services. All exhibitors/vendors of the Pine Rivers Show must comply with the latest Queensland Health advice at the time relevant to the show.
7. Grey water waste must be captured at all sites. Oil must be captured and emptied in the oil waste drums. Grey water tanks and oil tanks provided around the grounds.
8. All commercial rubbish must be removed from sites and placed in skip bins provided. Cardboard is to be flattened and placed in cardboard recycle bins. All sites must be kept in a clean, tidy condition during the show. If you require a bin at your site, you must supply this. Wheelie bins will be provided throughout the grounds and must not be moved to your sites.
9. Exhibitors/vendors vehicles (re-stocking) will only be admitted to the grounds between 6am – 8am Friday, Saturday & Sunday, through gate 3 (Pool Gate). You must display the supplied vehicle permit on the dashboard. ALL vehicles must be removed from the grounds by 8am each day without exception.
10. Exhibitors/vendors are reminded that Fairy Floss, Dagwood Dogs, Waffles, Donuts, Toffee Apples and Sno-cones, Cordial based drinks, Dolls on sticks, Inflatable toys & Plush toys shall be sold exclusively by members of the Showmen's Guild of Australasia.
11. The Pine Rivers AH&I Association accepts no liability for damages to exhibits by loss, damage, theft, fire, rain, storms, strikers, riots, profitability, or any cause whatever. Insurance for loss or damage is the responsibility



of the exhibitor. The Association is not responsible for the Site Holder's rain insurance or the profitability of your business during the show.

12. The following items are banned from being sold at Agricultural Shows. This list complies with Queensland Chamber of Agricultural Societies agreed list of banned items.:

Drug Related Goods (including Cocaine Kits, Bongs etc.)	Pressure pack snow & fart gas
Explicit & Hardcore T-shirts	Silly string
Fake Cigarettes	Stink Bombs
Fireworks/crackers	Bouncing beans
Fuel type fire lighters (Zippo)	Shang-hi/sling shots
Horn & Trumpets	Bomb bags
Knives (including pen knives)	Fire wallets
Laser pointers	Water bomb
Metal & wood martial art nunchakus	Explicit DVD's and Videos
Playing cards nude or lurid	Iridescent Hair Spray

Toy guns are acceptable; however the following are not acceptable:

Ball bearing guns	Replica guns (bullet type)
Eight shot caps	Roll caps
Pellet guns	Strip caps
Pop downs (throw downs)	Water pistols over 150mm
Potato guns	Gel blaster guns.

13. The Association reserves the right to postpone or amend the stated dates for the Show, using this right only where circumstances necessitate this action, and without any liability to the Association.
14. The Association reserves the right to cancel this contract and to retain all monies paid in relation thereto if there is or has been, in the opinion of the Association, any infringement of any part of the foregoing conditions and/or if the exhibitor does not occupy the said space at the commencement of and during the full period of the show.
15. Displays, stalls or fixtures may not be removed or dismantled before 4pm Sunday 2nd August 2026. After 5pm on Sunday vehicles may enter through Gate 5 and exit through Gate 2 – One Way traffic only. Failure to observe this may lead to exclusion from future shows.
16. Failure to comply with the condition may result in an exhibitor/vendor being excluded from participation in future shows.
