CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Exhibits for this section are being accepted after 4.00pm on Thursday 30th July 2026.

1 Floral Art section is located in the Horticulture Pavilion. To ease congestion, we ask that you please park in the main arena (entry via Lawnton pocket Rd) and walk your exhibit over to the hall or drop and park.

2 All Exhibits accepted up until 7.00pm and must be staged ready for judging at 7.30pm.

3 Entry Fee: - \$2 per item. Juniors - \$1 entry fee

4 No cars are allowed on the grounds on Sunday 2nd August until after 5pm.

5 Exhibits and prizes to be collected only between 4.00pm and 5.00pm Sunday afternoon 2nd August 2026. Any Exhibit not collected will be held and if not claimed within a fortnight, will become the property of the above Association to dispose of as they see fit.

6 Prize Money:	1st - \$20.00	2nd - \$10.00	3rd - \$5.00
Junior Prize Money	1st - \$10.00	2nd - \$5.00	3rd - \$2.00

7 Arrangements in all sections must fit within 80cm bench space (Junior, Novice and Intermediate may be smaller)

8 Judging of arrangements will be according to the Floral Art Association Handbook (AFAA) and the Judge on the day. Judges results are final

9 Exhibits will be displayed on benches, tablecloths are Black. Exhibits will be viewed from all sides.

10 Flowers for floral work need not be grown by exhibitor

11 Foliage Arrangements - Allows use of any type of foliage or leaves, buds or bracts. No Flowers or fruits.

12 Any plant material, bases or accessories are allowed unless otherwise stated.

13 One Champion Floral Art Sash for overall winner. All prizes stated above may be substituted with a trophy or voucher to that value.

-  Jelly Bean Bright and Beautiful in a Basket

OPEN CLASS

-  Blooms, Balls and Beads Simplicity
-  Table Arrangement
-  Red

JUNIOR CLASS

-  Crazy Critters

Flowers, fruit, vegetable etc. Used to create a recognisable or imaginary creature or animal

-  Design in a Novelty container

Plant material arranged in anything that fits the term "novelty" eg. watering can, boot, teapot, kitchen utensil, beach bucket, toy etc.
