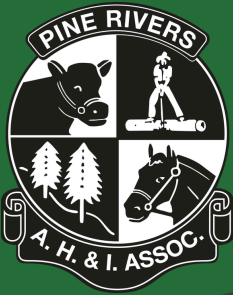

Terms and Conditions of Entry (General)

- **The acceptance of any entry is subject to the discretion of the Chief Steward**
Online entry is preferred. Entry form and entry fees should be paid prior to 19th July 2026 either sent to the Association or transferred online. Full details are provided on the Entry Form. A manual entry form can be printed from [this website](#). A link is provided on this site for you to complete your online entry
- All entries must be recent (within 3 years) and be the original, unaided work of the exhibitor (not copied), and not previously exhibited in a Pine Rivers Show. No work may be entered in more than one class.
Dependent on the number of entries received and space available, it is possible not all entered art/craft may be displayed during the show but will be judged prior to the opening of the show. The Chief Steward reserves the right to declare a non-competition in any class in which there are less than three entries; if a class has a limited number of entries, a third prize may not be awarded.
- All decisions by the judges will be final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into. Please respect all volunteers. They are giving their time freely for the success of the show.
- A commission of 20% will be retained for all sales.
- All care will be taken with the exhibits, but the Association will not be responsible for loss, theft or damage to the exhibits. Artists should take out their own insurance if they consider it necessary.
- The Association reserves the right to photograph any work submitted for the purpose of documentation, education and advertising in any media form.
- Please use the **2026 Entry Form either online or the manual form which can be downloaded from the Art & Craft section**. Every individual item must be listed on your entry form. Please note there are a significant number of changes to the classifications in the classification schedule. Please review carefully when completing your entry form.
- Nominated prize money may consist of cash, vouchers or goods.

Specific Terms and Conditions of Entry (Paint)

- All pictures and paintings are to be correctly labelled on the back of the artwork (class, title, artist's name and sale price)
- Works must be suitably mounted and framed with D-rings placed one third of the way down the frame; exception is paintings on block canvas where the artist considers no frame is necessary. Children's artwork can be mounted on standard mounting board with hanging wire attached (If possible, please avoid using plastic photo frames; these are difficult to hang). All artwork must be ready for hanging with strong wire/cord, flush not protruding, or other professional methods. This applies to adult entries. If not for sale, exhibit needs to be marked NFS. If not for judging, exhibit needs to be marked NFJ. All entries in school-aged classes must be either framed ready for hanging or mounted on suitable strength mounting board ready to hang.
- The size of any painting including the frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm.
- A maximum of 5 entries only per artist will be accepted with listed. No more than 2 entries in any classification.
- Artwork must be the original unaided work of the artist and not generated digitally using AI. No prints of artwork will be accepted.
- All Artwork must be suitable for general public exhibition.
- Exhibitor's submission on entry implies acceptance of all conditions.

Specific Terms and Conditions of Entry (Craft)

- Every individual piece of work must be on the entry form; this includes each individual item in a collection.
- Extra entry forms may be photocopied or collected from the Show Office at the Showgrounds.
- Every individual item including items in collections must have a tag showing name and selling price
 - If not for sale, exhibit needs to be marked NFS
 - If not for judging, exhibit needs to be marked NFJ
- Each item will be judged in one class only.
- A collection of craft items for sale only or display may be entered once a payment fee of \$5.00 per collection is paid. A full inventory listing all items and prices must be supplied at time of delivery. The quantity will depend on available space.

130	Scapes	Any medium. This class invites artworks depicting natural, coastal or urban environments including landscapes, seascapes and cityscapes. Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
131	Flora and Fauna	Any medium. This class invites representations of wildlife, flowers and insects including botanical artworks and wildlife/animal portraits Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
132	Human Form	Any medium. This class invites artworks that include full figures, partial figures or portraits. They may range from highly detailed realism to expressive interpretations. Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
133	Still Life	Any medium. This class invites representations of subject matter which includes, but not limited to, fruit, flowers, vases, books etc Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
134	Abstracts	Any medium. This class invites artworks that are simplified, distorted or non-representational focusing on expression, movement or concept instead of accurate depiction. Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
135	Artist with a disability care partner or residing in a care facility	Any medium, any subject Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
136	Primary school students Prep – Grade 3	Any medium, any subject. Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
137	Primary school students Grades 4 – 6	Any medium, any subject. Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
138	High school students Grades 7 – 10	Any medium, any subject. Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
139	High school students Grades 11 – 12	Any medium, any subject. Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
140	High School Students Digital Art	The artwork must be an original creation by the student and not created wholly or partially by AI
141	Sculpture	Any subject, any medium, any technique. Must be ready for display and not exceeding 3 kilos.
142	Pottery - Wheel Thrown

145	Paper Craft	Includes cards, scrapbooking on and off page, quilling, paper tole etc
