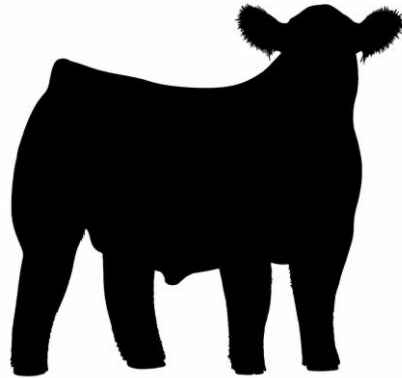

### **RULES OF CATTLE SECTION THESE RULES WILL BE STRICTLY OBSERVED**

1. All cattle are eligible except those from restricted or quarantined herds.
2. Cattle must not be introduced if they are from a property or herd in which Johne's disease has been known, or suspected, to exist during the five-year period prior to the show.
3. All entries, with the exception of a led steer or heifer (led steer or heifer class), or a calf exhibited at foot (stud class), must be registered in a herd book of their respective Breed Society, and proof of registration must be available if requested.
4. All cattle must be carrying an approved **NLIS device** and will be scanned at a time to be advised.
5. All cattle must be accompanied by a valid **NVD/Waybill** and a **Cattle Health Declaration** (please have documents available at the time of scanning).
6. All cattle must be on the grounds no later than **Saturday 6:30am** for scanning.
7. All cattle must be **TICK FREE**.
8. All cattle exhibited must be the bona-fide property of the exhibitor.
9. All electrical leads, tools and electrical equipment **MUST** be tested by a licensed electrical contractor and tagged in accordance with safety regulations.
10. **THE AGE OF CATTLE** will be their actual age calculated as of **1 August** in the current year.
11. Maximum age of a calf at foot is 9 months. Maximum age of a bull is 48 months.
12. Calves that are part of a Cow/Calf unit are not permitted to be exhibited as an individual.
13. Cattle must be under control at all times.
14. Bulls 12 months and over must have a permanent nose ring and led by halter. Females 12 months and over must have a permanent nose ring or nose grip and led by halter.
15. **All cattle must be thoroughly tractable and able to be led safely.**
16. **NO UNTRAINED** beast allowed on the grounds.
17. All cattle must be secured by lead rope and have a neck collar/strap secured whilst in stalls.
18. All animals over 12 months must bear a brand or tattoo.
19. The Committee reserves the right to alter classes where appropriate.
20. If, in the opinion of the Judge, entries are unworthy of a prize, no award will be given.
21. Exhibitors exhibit at their own risk. The Pine Rivers Show Society will not accept liability for stock exhibited. All exhibitors must carry public liability insurance that extends to include exhibiting cattle at agricultural shows.
22. **No livestock to leave prior 3.00pm when the gates will be unlocked.**
23. **All vehicles will require a Show Society Escort to move through the grounds.**
24. **The Pine Rivers Show is a non-smoking event.**

### **YOUNG JUDGES COMPETITION (AGE at the 1<sup>st</sup> May) To be Judged Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> August after Stud Judging**

#### **Conditions of Entry No Fee**

No less than 4 animals of a prescribed breed to be judged.

Each competitor will be given a card, on which they will place the animals in their order of merit. On completion of the card, it will be handed to the Steward for presentation to the Judge.

Selected entrants will be asked to speak on the animals.

The judge/s on making their award, shall take into consideration the correctness of the placings and the reasons given.

#### **Conditions of Entry No Fee**

Entrants may lead an animal of any Beef breed, of any age or sex. The emphasis of this Class is on the Entrants ability to prepare and parade the animal and present their exhibit to the Judge. Entrants should pay particular attention to their own attire and presentation, as well as that of their animal.

### **STUD BEEF CATTLE – GROUP INTERBREED CLASSES**

**9. Interbreed Pair of Bulls:** To consist of 2 bulls of the same breed, any age, owned and exhibited by the exhibitor and entered in the general classes.

**10. Interbreed Pair of Females:** To consist of 2 females of the same breed, any age, owned and exhibited by the exhibitor and entered in the general classes.

**11. Interbreed Exhibitors Group:** To consist of 3 animals of the same breed, both sexes to be represented. All animals to be owned and exhibited by the exhibitor and entered in the general classes.

## **LED STEER OR HEIFER CLASSES**
