## TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY - GENERAL

**1 Use separate entry forms for PAINT and CRAFT entries.**

Entry form and entry fees should be paid prior to **16 July 2021** either sent to the Association or online. Full details are provided on the Entry Form. A manual entry form can be printed from the website ([www.pineriversshow.org.au](http://www.pineriversshow.org.au)) or a link is provided on this site for you to complete your entry online.

**Entry Fees for 2021 only**

Adult	\$5 per entry incl GST
Junior	\$2.50 per entry incl GST
Care Facility Clients	\$2.50 per entry incl GST
Paper Craft	\$3 per entry incl GST

- 2** All entries must be recent (within 2 years) and be the original, unaided work of the exhibitor (not copied), and not previously exhibited in a Pine Rivers Show. No work may be entered in more than one class.
- 3** Due to Covid-19 restrictions in social distancing, it is possible not all entered art/craft may be displayed during the show but will be judged prior to the opening of the show. The Chief Steward reserves the right to declare a non-competition in any class in which there are less than three entries.
- 4** A commission of 20% will be retained for all sales
- 5** All care will be taken with the exhibits but the Association will not be responsible for loss or damage to the Exhibits
- 6** The Association reserves the right to photograph any work submitted for the purpose of documentation, education and advertising in any media form
- 7** Retain your receipt for entry fees. You must produce this as proof of ownership when collecting entries at the closure of the show
- 8** Please use the **2021 ENTRY FORM**. Every individual item must be listed on your entry form.
- 9** Any nominated prize money may be substituted with a voucher or goods.



## **SPECIFIC TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – PAINT**

- 1 All pictures and paintings are to be correctly labelled on the back of the artwork (class, title, artist's name and sale price)

If not for sale, exhibit needs to be marked NFS

If not for judging, exhibit needs to be marked NFJ

- 2 Works must be suitably mounted and framed except for paintings on block canvas where the artist considers no frame is necessary; all artwork must be labelled showing name and selling price. All artwork must be ready for hanging with strong wire/cord, flush not protruding, or other professional methods. This applies to adult and child entries.
- 3 The size of any painting including the frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm.
- 4 A maximum of 5 entries only per artist will be accepted.

## **SPECIFIC TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – CRAFT**

- 1 Every individual piece of work must be on the entry form; this includes each individual item in as collection.

If not for sale, exhibit needs to be marked NFS

If not for judging, exhibit needs to be marked NFJ

- 2 Every individual item including items in collections must have a tag showing name or code and selling price. If using a code use the first 2 letters of your surname (eg Smith = sm1, sm2 etc.
- 3 Any 1 item will be judged in one class only
- 4 A collection of craft items for sale only or display may be entered once a payment fee of \$3.50 per collection is paid. The quantity displayed will depend on available space and current Covid-19 Health recommendations.

## PINE RIVERS ART & CRAFT SHOW 2021 CLASSIFICATIONS

### ART

<b>CLASS 1</b>	<b>Open class – any subject, figurative – using oils, acrylic or gouache</b>	Eg: embodying any recognisable figures or elements. Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
<b>CLASS 2</b>	<b>Open class – native Australian wildlife, flora and fauna only – any painting medium</b>	Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
<b>CLASS 3</b>	<b>Drawing – any subject – any drawing medium</b>	Eg: pencil, pen, conte, pastel, crayon etc. Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
<b>CLASS 4</b>	<b>Traditional watercolour – any subject in watercolour</b>	Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
<b>CLASS 5</b>	<b>Open class – marine/seascape – any painting medium</b>	Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
<b>CLASS 6</b>	<b>Open class – using soft pastels – traditional representational artwork only</b>	Mixed media must be predominantly soft pastel. No oil pastels. Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
<b>CLASS 7</b>	<b>Non-traditional painting or drawing</b>	Any subject using non-traditional interpretation. This class allows the artist more scope to use media techniques, subject matter etc in a way which would be restricted in the more traditional classes. Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm



<b>CLASS 8</b>	<b>Still Life</b>	Painting in oils or synthetic polymer paints (acrylic), watercolour or gouache of a group of objects arranged by the artist. Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
<b>CLASS 9</b>	<b>Primary school students Prep – year 3</b>	Any medium, any subject Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
<b>CLASS 10</b>	<b>Primary school students Years 4 – 6</b>	Any medium, any subject Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
<b>CLASS 11</b>	<b>High school students Years 7 – 10</b>	Any medium, any subject Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
<b>CLASS 12</b>	<b>High school students Years 11 – 12</b>	Any medium, any subject Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm
<b>CLASS 13</b>	<b>Care Facility Clients Entrants for this class must reside in or attend a Care Facility</b>	Any medium, any subject Size including frame must not exceed 80cm x 100cm

<b>CLASS 14</b>	<b>Pottery – wheel thrown</b>	
<b>CLASS 15</b>	<b>Pottery – hand-built sculpture</b>	
<b>CLASS 16</b>	<b>Bark or wool picture</b>	
<b>CLASS 17</b>	<b>Paper craft – Cards</b>	Open to all artists
<b>CLASS 18</b>	<b>Paper craft – Cards – NOVICE</b>	Artist NOT to have previously won a prize in card making in Pine Rivers Show
<b>CLASS 19</b>	<b>Paper craft – Scrapbooking</b>	Album page
<b>CLASS 20</b>	<b>Paper craft – any item</b>	Eg: Scrapbooking off the page, quilling, paper tole etc
<b>CLASS 21</b>	<b>Jewellery</b>	Any medium
<b>CLASS 22</b>	<b>Pyrography</b>	
<b>CLASS 23</b>	<b>Wood – turned bowl</b>	Any size



<b>CLASS 24</b>	<b>Wood – any other item</b>	
<b>CLASS 25</b>	<b>Wood – NOVICE</b>	
<b>CLASS 26</b>	<b>Wood – toys</b>	
<b>CLASS 27</b>	<b>High school students years 7-12 Wood – turned bowl</b>	Any size
<b>CLASS 28</b>	<b>High school students years 7-12 Wood – any other item</b>	
<b>CLASS 29</b>	<b>Primary school students Craft</b>	Any medium
<b>CLASS 30</b>	<b>High school students Craft</b>	Any medium
<b>CLASS 31</b>	<b>Care Facility clients Craft</b>	Any medium Entrants must attend or reside in a care facility
<b>CLASS 32</b>	<b>Craft – other</b>	Any medium – NOT eligible to be entered into classes 14-31 inclusive
