3. All produce not collected by Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2020 will be disposed of.
4. Entry fee - Adults: \$1 per class; Junior 50 cents per class, Junior Classes 69,70 and 74 No Entry Fee
5. All exhibits must be accompanied by a **completed entry form** and be delivered to the Horticulture pavilion on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2020 between 3.00 pm and 6.30pm and staged ready for judging at 7.00pm.  
Prize money 1st - \$5.00; 2nd - \$3.00 (unless otherwise stated); 3rd - place card only  
Prize Money above halved, if less than 3 entries  
Junior section will be awarded ribbons.
6. Points allocated - 1st - 3 points; 2nd - 2 points; 3<sup>rd</sup> - 1 point
