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SECONDARY SCHOOLS WINE CHALLENGE

2020 PINE RIVERS SHOW

Rules & conditions:

1. The competition is open exclusively to wines made by currently enrolled secondary students.
2. For the 2020 Show, the classes are divided into the fruit the wine is made from. In the case of those wines made on banana or another wine base with another fruit as the flavour it is the flavoured fruit which should decide its class. It is the responsibility of the entrant to decide the class the wine is to be entered into. However, see Rule 4 below.
3. Sweet and dry wines will be accepted into the same class.
4. A wine entered out of class may be moved to another class at the discretion of the judges. If there aren't any wines that are of a particular class, the class groups may be changed to suit.
5. Schools may enter wines made by individuals or group of students.
6. Entries restricted to individual or group of students from each school.
7. Entries are limited to a **maximum of 30 entries per school**.
8. Wine should be bottled in colourless, clear wine bottles, which should be clean of markings, have shoulders and use a plastic stopper or a screw lid. Bottle size is not a major concern.
9. Bottles are to be tagged with school name, student name or student group ID, class number and name (e.g. Class 1 Banana Wine). Any herbs used are to be identified. These labels will be removed or covered by the steward and the bottles labelled or placed in a bag so as the judges are unaware of the school they are judging.
10. The school wines must be dropped off and collected by the representative of the particular school. Please make suitable arrangements with the Steward.
11. The Schools Challenge Champion Wine for 2020 will be awarded to the highest scoring wine of the competition.
12. **Entries will only be accepted on these conditions ...Entry Fee \$1.00 per bottle.**
13. The judge's decision is final and no discussion on the judging of a specific wine will be entered into.
14. **Notes to the classifications for the 2020 Pine Rivers Show.** Wines will be classified according to the predominant fruit of their production.

Schedule of Classes: (classes can be changed depending on the type of fruit used and entered in the competition, also sometimes more than 10 classes)

Class 1.	Banana Wine
Class 2.	Apple Wine
Class 3.	Plum Wine
Class 4.	Pineapple Wine
Class 5.	Orange Wine
Class 6.	Peach Wine
Class 7.	Raspberry Wine
Class 8.	Passionfruit Wine
Class 9.	Blends of fruits
Class 10.	Wines not fitting any of the above classes

Scoring System: The wines will be judged on the standard Australian Wine Show judging 20 points score system as follows:

Colour and condition: 3 points
 Nose: 7 points
 Palate: 10 points

A show judging score sheet is appended to these rules. Points awarded by each judge will be aggregated to determine the first, second, third places and any high commended wines. Wines scoring below an average of 14 points will not be available for a highly commended classification.
